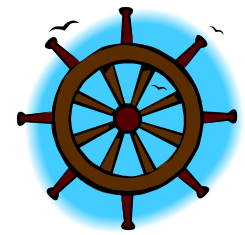

Winter is on us and typically not much sailing gets done this time of year. The Board is using the time to put the overall schedule together for next year's activities and plan for this year's Gunter'sville Cup. At the December meeting, we have decided to continue with all of the activities we completed last year and add several new ones. We will start with a clinic on racing rules on January 19<sup>th</sup>, followed by dinner out with the group. Then in February, we will kick off our regular 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday schedule with a 2pm sail trim and tactics clinic, followed by the Board meeting and then our ever popular chili cook-off. Plan on bringing down your best chili and joining in on the fun.

Our only raft-up last year had 17 boats participate, and all had a great time, so this year we are planning three raft-ups with the first on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. We are also adding 3 moonlight sails, with the first on May 17<sup>th</sup>, following our Board meeting and low country boil. You'll need to keep posted on the schedule to make sure you don't miss any of the social activities.

Last year we also had as many, if not more, boats participate in the Sunday pursuit races as the Saturday races. Following that lead, Keith has put together a schedule for both Saturday and Sunday races that include 5 races each for spring, summer and fall, for a total of 30 races. Add to that the Joint Pursuit Race series, the Gunter'sville Cup, Autumn Challenge and several "fun" races and we will have the best season ever. Now we just have to find a way to get the wind to cooperate.

It will not be long and the weather will start warming up and the days will get longer and we can all get back to spending more time on the docks. We have several new members and it is incumbent on all of the rest of us to make sure they feel welcome to all of our activities. Remember, all Board meetings (3<sup>rd</sup> Sat. of each month) are open to all members and all comments are welcome. We will usually have some sort of social or educational activity associated with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday meetings, so plan on joining us. On any given Saturday evening, when there are several members around, we will usually decide on a local restaurant for dinner and all are welcome to join us.

Well, it's winter and the snow is flying out west, so I've got to get back to packing for our annual ski trip. We look forward to seeing all on the docks soon.

Dick Potter and I got inspired last weekend to prepare for the Guntersville Cup and developed a “healthy” schedule for this year. Dick will post the Guntersville Cup Notice of Race (go to the LGSC web-site [www.lakeguntersvillesailingclub.com](http://www.lakeguntersvillesailingclub.com) for the notice of race and entry form)so you can garner the particulars from that. Basically it will start with a dinner and skipper’s meeting Friday night, April 18<sup>th</sup>. We will start the race bright and early Saturday morning, April 19<sup>th</sup>, and try for three races. That way we can allow one throw out incase you have a little difficulty during one of the events. We follow it up with a super dinner by Kathy and the Social Committee and an awards presentation. Plan on it!! We will have several fleets and prizes covering accomplished as well as beginning sailors so there will be something for everyone.

We went whole hog on the pursuit races. There will be 30 races in all broken up into six different series. There will be a separate Saturday and Sunday series in the Spring, Summer and Fall. That makes up the six series. Within each series there will be five races with two throw outs allowed. Therefore you only need to make it to three races in any one series to be prize eligible. Lots of opportunity to sail!!! We will have awards for the winners of each series as well as an overall Club Champion and Most Improved Sailor. The awards are courtesy of an anonymous donor. Thank you very much!! We will also be starting the Saturday races later, noon, and the Sunday races earlier, noon again. Theory was that it was tough for the out-of-towners to get to the club early on Saturday. Then, we were hoping they might stay over, race on Sunday and have plenty of time to get home. Let’s plan on some Saturday night dock parties!!!! Bev and I might even stay over for that.

Still going to do the Joint Pursuit with Brown’s Creek but I am going to move them to Sundays instead of Saturday. It is easier to coordinate to their schedule since the vast majority of their races are on Saturdays. We will start these an hour later, at noon. Plan is for four Joint Pursuits and the first lap of the Great River Race to count in this series.

The Lake Guntersville Sailing Club (LGSC) is pleased to invite you to participate in the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Guntersville Cup Regatta to be held out of the Lake Guntersville Marina (formerly Anchorage Marina) Rte. 431 north of Guntersville on beautiful Lake Guntersville, Alabama. This is a one-day, two-or-more races regatta.

\*ASAP - As soon as possible after the preceding race.

**Rules:** The Regatta is open to all mono-hull sailing boats with an enclosed cabin and greater than 20-ft. waterline length and will be governed by the 2005-2008 Rules of Racing, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the Navigation Rules International/Inland Waterways, and the Sailing Instructions.

**Fleets:** There will be three fleets: A-Open Portsmouth with Spinnaker, B-Open Portsmouth without Spinnaker, and C-Novice for owner/helmspersons who have never competed in an organized sailing race before. Portsmouth Ratings will be determined by the Race Committee based on the data required to complete registration. In the event a fleet is over-subscribed, the Race Committee may divide the fleet into two separate classes. In the event there are too few boats to constitute a fleet, the Race Committee may determine in which of the remaining fleets those boats will compete.

**Sailing Instructions:** Will be available on the LGSC web site on-or-about April 1, 2008 and also available at the Skippers meeting, 1900 Friday April 18 at the LGSC Club House.

**Course:** Races will be held in the Tennessee River between the Siebold Light and the Upper Guntersville Light with the start in the vicinity of the Short Creek Light.

**Prizes:** Separate awards will be given for up to three places in each fleet having at least eight boats. The Race Committee will award Special Prizes as it sees fit.
