We had another event up in the LGSC area. Six boats showed up at the start. Again people learned about being close to the line at the start no matter how hard the wind is blowing!!! One took off, one just could not point that day and three crossed the finish within 1.5 minutes of each other. Again a nice testimonial to the handicapping system. I think if you ask anyone who participated in the Pursuit Series they will tell you it is a lot of fun and really lets you test your sailing skills without being scared to death at the start! As a matter of fact the reaction was so good people begged us to add more events between now and June 3<sup>rd</sup>. 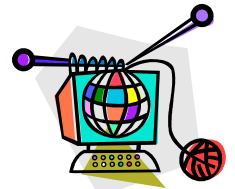
